



Congratulations!

You have recently been approved by the Kansas Social and Rehabilitation Services (SRS) to provide services on the Autism Waiver. **Kansas SRS requires that all waiver providers complete a state-approved training within 6 months of becoming approved.**

The Kansas Center for Autism Research and Training (K-CART) Autism Training Program at the University of Kansas Medical Center provides this state-approved training. We are the currently the only provider for the statewide training mandated for those who wish to provide services under the SRS waiver.

We offer the following trainings every other month:

Autism Specialist/Intensive Individual Supports Provider:

Trainees must be present for 6 days of training. Training consists of 3 components:

1. Online informational tutorials: Ten modules with a pre- and post-test. These tutorials are mandatory only if a trainee scores less than 90% on the pre-test.
2. Experiential/On-the Job Training: The first five days of this training take place at the University of Kansas Medical Center in Kansas City, KS. These days will be split between time spent in clinic training and On-the-Job Training at collaborative agencies and/or with families in the metropolitan Kansas City and Lawrence, KS sites—3-5 hours daily. The sixth day of training will take place at the University of Kansas, Lawrence Campus and will consist of lecture and experiential training on functional assessment, with the opportunity to observe/participate in a functional analysis.
3. Follow-Up/Support: Once training is completed, all participants are required to send in six 10-minute videotapes of themselves working with a child. These videotapes will be scored and returned to the participant with feedback.

Autism Specialist Only—The Above 6-day training is strongly recommended.

Below is the minimum requirement:

Trainees must be present for two days of training. Training consists of 3 components:

1. Online informational tutorials: Ten modules with a pre- and post-test. These tutorials are mandatory only if a trainee scores less than 90% on the pre-test.
2. Assessment Training: This training consists of two consecutive days. One day will be at the University of Kansas Medical Center in Kansas City, KS; the other will be spent at the University of Kansas in Lawrence.
3. Follow-Up/Support: Once training is completed, all participants are required to send in six 10-minute videotapes of themselves working with a child. These videotapes will be scored and returned to the participant with feedback.

Intensive Individual Support Provider

Trainees must be present for 6 days of training. Training consists of 3 components:

1. Online informational tutorials: Ten modules with a pre- and post-test. These tutorials are mandatory only if a trainee scores less than 90% on the pre-test.
2. Experiential/On-the Job Training: This training consists of six days at the University of Kansas Medical Center in Kansas City, KS. These days will be split between time spent in clinic training (3 hours) and On-the-Job Training at collaborative agencies and/or with families in the metropolitan Kansas City and Lawrence, KS sites (3 hours).

3. Follow-Up/Support: Once training is completed, all participants are required to send in six 10-minute videotapes of themselves working with a child. These videotapes will be scored and returned to the participant with feedback.

Respite Providers and Parent Support and Training Providers

Trainees must be present for three hours of training. Training consists of 2 components:

1. Online informational tutorials: Ten modules with a pre- and post-test. These tutorials are mandatory only if a trainee scores less than 90% on the pre-test.
2. Workshop: One three-hour workshop at the University of Kansas Medical Center in Kansas City, KS.

To register for the training, please go to www.autismtrainingprogram.com and select the month that you would like to attend the training. This does not ensure you a spot in this training, but does indicate the month that you would like to attend. There are limited spaces available in each training and it is first come, first serve. Because this training is only offered every other month and each training has a limited number of available slots, it is important that you plan ahead and enroll early in your 6-month window.
